

ANU Primary Schools Chess Championship 2006

All Primary Schools are invited to register a team of four players each to take part in the ANU Primary Schools Chess Championship, part of the 14th ANU Chess Festival 2006.

Primary School teams to report to the Registration Desk, Melville Hall, Ellery Crescent, Acton by 9.00am on Thursday 27 July 2006 (See map at <http://campusmap.anu.edu.au> and click on grid F-3. Building #12. The nearest paid car park is off Childers Street, adjacent to Buildings #105A and 110 on grid E-2. Walk down the pathway between Building #110 and Multi-story Car Park Building#99 and turn right at Ellery Crescent. Please use the door on the western end of Melville Hall which is closer to Building#11.)

- The tournament will be a 7 round format for all ACT and Regional Schools.
- Tournament size is limited to 40 teams. Schools may enter up to 3 teams, but second and third teams are subject to space being available. Teams consist of 4 players and may also include 1 reserve player.
- Entry Fee of \$24 per team with Trophies and Medallions for prize-winners.
- Each player has 15 minutes for all their moves and chess clocks will be used. Matches will be played over 4 boards.
- Players are asked to bring their lunches, although meals are available for purchase in the Student Union Building in Union Court (Building #20 on grid F-3 on the same map as above). It is important that schools organise a parent or teacher to supervise their team(s).

In the first week of Term 3, the “14th ANU Chess Festival 2006” Organising Committee is holding the “**ANU Primary Schools Chess Championship**” on **Thursday 27 July 2006** in **Melville Hall, ANU, Ellery Crescent, Acton**.

Tournament size is limited to 40 teams. Schools may enter up to 3 teams, but second and third teams are subject to space being available, because we would like as many schools as possible to take part in this tournament. Teams consist of 4 players and may also include 1 reserve player. **The closing date for entries is Monday 3 July 2006, although late entries will be accepted if space permits.** We will let you know how many teams from your school can participate by Tuesday 4 July at the latest.

* Prizes: (1) Perpetual trophy; (2) School (& individual) trophies for 1st, 2nd & 3rd teams; (3) Medals for Best Boards 1 – 4; (4) Medals for individuals with perfect scores

* Team Manager: The children should be accompanied by a team manager (teacher or parent) who is responsible for them, and can look after their needs during the day.

* Players are asked to bring their lunches, although meals are available for purchase in the Student Union, Union Court (Building #20 on grid F-3 on the same map as above).
